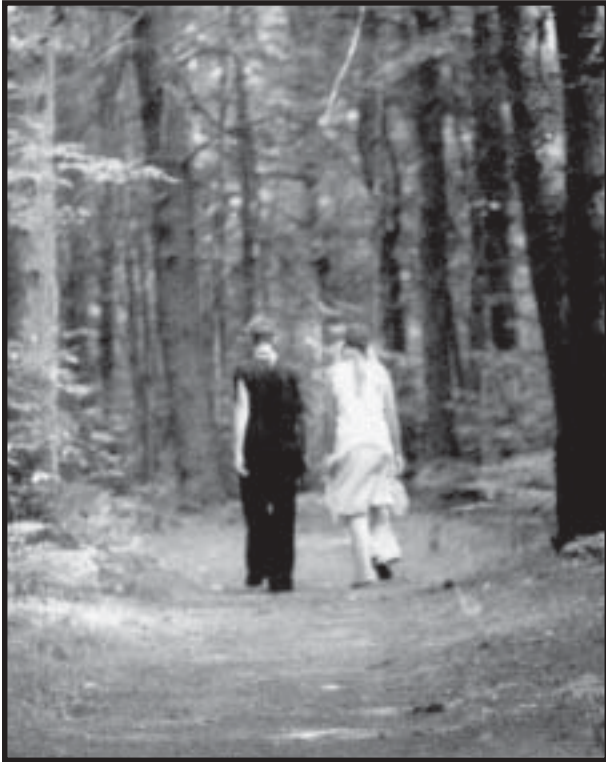


North Higgins Lake State Park



Hiking Trail System



Upland Nature Trail — 1.5 miles

Bosom Pines Trail — 3.8 miles

Beaver Creek Trail — 6.5 miles

The number 1 on the map is the beginning of the hiking trail system and the numbers 2 through 8 mark the intersections of the trails.

As you walk or ski the trails, you will cross narrow two track trails once used as fire breaks. These fire break trails are oriented North-South and East-West. They are indicated by straight lines that form a square grid on your map. Each square represents an area of 40 acres.

Dogs are prohibited on groomed ski trails.
