

Reservation Policies

1. All site assignments will be made by the Park Attendant or Park Supervisor. Specific sites can not be guaranteed. CHECK-IN/OUT IS 3:00 P.M.
2. Reservations may be made for the calendar year anytime after January 1.
3. A separate application must be submitted for each campsite. A separate application must be made for each period of time desired. An extension past the original reservation period is not guaranteed.
4. Full payment must accompany a reservation form, including \$4.00 reservation fee.
5. Mailed applications must be received 7 days prior to reservation date in order to receive a mailed confirmation.
6. Reservations may be made by mail, in person or by phone. No credit cards accepted November-April. Reservations forms are available at www.petoskey.us. 7-Day Tent Site Stay Limit.
7. Family Reservation = Mother and/or Father, unmarried children under age of 18. Group Reservation = No more than 4 unrelated persons.
8. Cancellations must be received 24 hours prior to reservation date in order to receive full refund, less reservation fee.
9. Cancellations received less than 24 hours prior to reservation date are subject to forfeiture of minimum night's fee (2 nights) and reservation fee.
10. After campsite has been occupied, no refund will be made for the minimum 2 nights. If camper fails to claim his/her reservation or fails to cancel the reservation, no refund will be made.
11. Confirmed reservations will be held for 24 hour only, unless the park is notified of later arrival.
12. Camping fee is subject to change. If the fee is increased after application is confirmed, camper agrees to pay the difference at time of arrival.

Magnus Park Campground

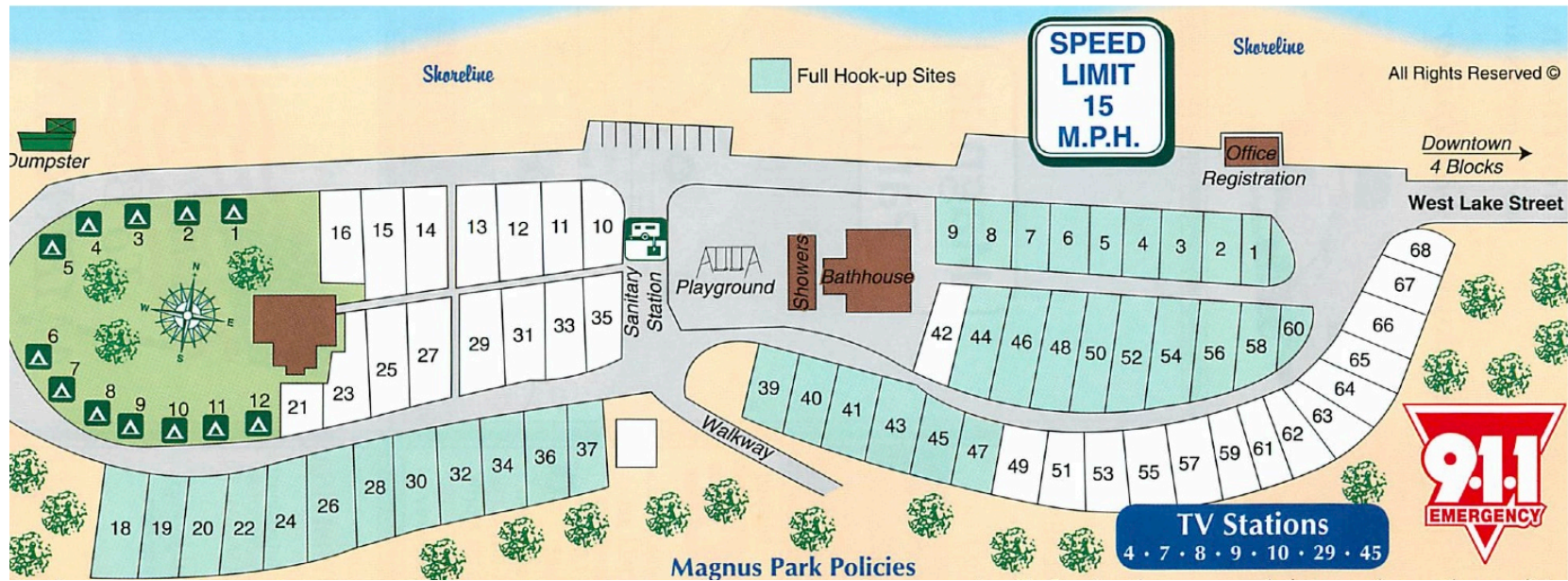

Regulations

- Camping & Fires in designated areas only. One picnic table per site.
- No camp shall occupy more than one site. One adult must register per site. No more than two cars per site.
- Quiet-time is from 11PM-7AM & Visitors must leave by 10PM.
- Trenching & Trimming is prohibited.
- Site Changes must be approved by staff. Extensions must be made by 10 AM on the day of extension & cannot be guaranteed.
- Pets must be under control & leashed.
- Violations of regulations may result in eviction from the park.
